STORE MARKET REPORT – FRIDAY 16th JULY 2010

CALVES (64)

A slightly reduced entry of mixed quality sold on a solid trade with best demand for better heifers and all types of Friesian bulls.

Beef Breeds (50) Smart bulls still £260 plus to a top of £315 for a choice Charolais from **HG Harvey & Son**, £310 was achieved by **MR & KL Davey** with a grand Simmental bull. Blues to £288 for **L & M Coles**. Best native bulls £200 plus with South Devons leading the way at £225 for **R H Rew & Son**. Decent heifers sold on a blistering trade with an exceptionally bred South Devon heifer leading the way at £298 for **M D Partridge**. **H G Harvey & Son** also sold a smart Charolais heifer at £288. Blues seriously contested topping at £262 for W E Parr.

Dairy Breeds(14) All types keenly contested to average £77.50 apiece. British Friesians led the way at £140,£138 £130 from **Messrs Froom, White & Coles** respectively.

STIRKS (34)

A much smaller than anticipated entry due no doubt to the sudden change in the weather. A stronger trade for all sorts selling to a top of £460 for a real quality Hereford steer, 9 months old, from **W H Discombe**. Heifers peaked at £438 for a 10 month old British Blue from **Mr R G Tucker** with **W H Discombe** at £392 for an 8 month old pedigree Hereford heifer. Many more stirks could have been sold to advantage with plenty of buyers looking.
