CALVES (40)

Numbers remain scarce but a real flier at a trade and many more could have been sold to advantage.

Beef Breeds An excellent entry of continental bulls averaged £272 apiece. Top price of the day was £334 for a British Blue from **Mr G Parkman** with **J D Hendy & Son** with another British Blue at £330. **Messrs DA & AP Gillbard** sold a Limousin at £318, **M R Davey** a Limousin at £295 and £288 and **A J Parker** made £282 for a Limousin. Best sorts £270 plus and mediums at around £240 with none under £200. Heifers to £238 for **M R Davey** for a Limousin with **A W Harris & Son** at £235 for a Limousin and **J D Hendy & Son** made £230 with a British Blue. Best sorts £220 plus and Mediums at around £180 with heifers averaging £183 apiece.

Dairy Breeds British Friesians to £134 twice both from **SJ & MD Loud** and averaging £93 apiece. Holstein Friesians to £100 from **M D Pyle** with most at £50 to £60 and averaging £57 apiece.

***** IMPORTANT NOTICE - FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION *****

As of 1ST JANUARY 2010 Food Chain Information (FCI) must be provided by livestock keepers for all cattle, sheep and goats sent for slaughter including livestock markets

You will no doubt have received notification of this and what information is needed in correspondence from the Food Standards Agency sent to all livestock farmers recently.

We will need this information here in the Market to pass on to our slaughterhouse buyers. We will need a new style buff coloured Exeter Market Entry Form to accompany your stock to market as by filling in the animal details on the front, and signing the form, the declaration on the back will confirm that your animals are fit for human consumption. This applies to all stock on a Monday market & some of the stock on Friday markets as some animals from the store market may go to slaughter. If your animals are still under restriction for slaughter on Fridays i.e. withdrawal dates etc. then you will need to declare this and notify the person booking in your stock.

New AML1 forms for sheep and goat movements are available which have a section on the back for you to enter FCI.

Can Vendors who have cull ewes as well as lambs PLEASE make sure that they submit SEPARATE EMA Entry Forms as the new DEFRA AML1 Forms only require the total number. We now have a new buff coloured Entry Form with an FCI Declaration on which will cover your animals to go to slaughter. This will help in making sure that your sheep are correctly booked in & it is very much in your own interest to do so if you want your cheque on time.

PLEASE PUT YOUR FABBL STICKERS ON THE MARKET ENTRY FORM NOT ON YOUR MOVEMENT FORMS AS IT CAUSES CONFUSION WHEN BOOKING IN YOUR STOCK.

A really good number entry sold to a slightly easier trade than last week with the overall average actually down 5p/kg. and £2.50 per head on the week, although there were a number of very lean lambs forward this week. Top price per kilo was 199p/kg. for two pens, firstly for a pen of 43.2 kg. from **Mr C Wakeham** that realised £86.00 and secondly for pen of 43.8 kg. for **Master Ross Skelley of Ivybridge** that realised £87.20. Stronger and heavier well-fleshed lambs met best demand selling to £90 for a pen of 50 kg. from Messrs D A & A P Gillbard.
