STORE MARKET REPORT – FRIDAY 9th JULY 2010

CALVES (76)

A good entry met a mixed trade with plainer and medium sorts, particularly Friesians, a seriously fast trade. Many buyers competing strongly but better quality, particularly, stronger calves looking an easier trade on recent weeks.

Beef Breeds Top price of the day was £328 for a Charolais from **Messrs H G Harvey & Son** with **D Kittow** at £320 and **E Kingdom** at £300, both for British Blues. **R Harvey** sold a quality Limousin at £288. Heifers peaked at £264 from **Miss A Hayden** for a strong Simmental with **E Kingdom** at £255 for a British Blue with **Miss A Hayden** at £245 for a Simmental and **W E Tucker** at £240 for a Simmental worthy of mention.

Dairy Breeds Friesians a blistering trade peaking at £200 for a stronger sort from **DJF & E Burrough** with **G Parkman** at £130, **Dowrich Farms** at £122 for a British Friesian and the Black & Whites averaging £74 apiece !!

STIRKS (34)

Mostly younger sorts forward met a selective trade with demand easier. No doubt due to the lack of grass in most parishes. Top price of the day was £350 apiece for a bunch of Blonde steers from **Rushford Mill Farm**. **Miss A Hayden** sold a 3 month old Simmental steer at £330. Heifers to £275 apiece from **Mr D Phillips** with the same vendor at £268 for similar types. **Rushford Mill** sold Blonde heifers to £270 and **Miss A Hayden** and **W E Tucker** both sold 3 month old Simmentals to £252 apiece.

A few more store pigs met a firm demand with several buyers keen for all sizes with a top of £50 per head. 33 Finished pigs continued to sell well for the quality types to top at £85 a head and 90.0p/kg. liveweight. Coloured sorts a little harder to sell. 30 cull sows met an easier trade, as expected, due to the national drop, but still sold to over 65.0p/kg. liveweight.
